## What are Voting Methods?

A voting method defines

1) the form of the ballot,
2) what constitutes a valid vote,
3) how to count votes, and
4) an algorithm for determining the outcome of the election.

A voting method is not to be confused with an election system, which is concerned with whether or not to have early voting, allmail elections, electronic or paper ballots, etc.

## APPROVAL VOTING

- Vote for one or more dessert candidates.
- You are not required to approve more than one candidate.

## SCORE VOTING

- To vote, rate each choice by clearly circling one score in that dessert's row. The worst score is 0 . The best score is 3 .
- You may give EQUAL scores to different desserts.
- To determine the winner, add up the scores for each dessert. The dessert with the highest total wins.

## INSTANT RUNOFF VOTING

- Write $\mathbf{1}$ in the circle next to your favorite dessert.
- If you would like to rank some or all of the remaining desserts, write $\mathbf{2}$ next to your $2^{\text {nd }}$ favorite dessert, and then write 3 next to your $3^{\text {rd }}$ favorite dessert if desired, and write 4 next to your least favorite dessert if desired.

## Instant Runoff Voting (IRV)

Counting the votes in rounds or "runoffs"
$1^{\text {st }}$ Round - If a dessert receives a majority of 1st-choice votes, it wins. Otherwise, begin the $2^{\text {nd }}$ round.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ Round - The dessert with the fewest 1 st-choice votes is eliminated, and the 2nd-choice votes on those ballots are counted and added to the first-round tally If a dessert now has a majority of the active votes, it wins. If not, round 3.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ Round - The dessert with the fewest votes is once again eliminated and the next available favorite on those ballots is counted in the tally. After two desserts are eliminated, the remaining dessert with the greatest number of votes wins.

The League supports authorizing and implementing alternatives to plurality voting that allow people to express their preferences more effectively. The League supports gaining on-the-ground experience with alternative voting methods in order to ascertain whether a voting method results in outcomes that match voters' preferences as recorded on their ballots. The League supports voting methods that improve the election experience, that encourage honest voting rather than tactical voting, and that consider ease of implementation.

Considerations:

- Some voting methods are intended for single-winner elections, others for multiwinner elections. It is important that the intended use of a voting method match its actual application. Multi-winner voting methods can promote proportional representation that fosters diversity of our elected officials.
- Election officials should conduct post-election analysis to evaluate the voters' usage of the voting method and the election's reflection of voters' stated preferences. There should be sufficient data transparency - for example, access to ballot records in anonymous form - for an independent analysis to be conducted by other interested groups.
